

Akron Civic Theatre's Huntington Access for All Program

Each year, the Akron Civic Theatre distributes more than 10,000 free tickets to economically challenged families and senior citizens who may otherwise not have access to events at the theater.

Giving *all* members of our community access to the experience of live performing arts is one of the Civic's priorities. Our Huntington Access for All program, supported by the Huntington – Akron Fund, helps us accomplish this through our partnerships with 65 area social service agencies. Additionally, we are able to accept Ohio EBT cards directly from community members for access to select events at the theater.

Approximately 100 events of our annual schedule of 200+ events — in both the main auditorium and on our new stage in the neighboring Whitelaw building — include Huntington Access for All tickets. Events eligible for the program feature a wide range of musical genres, drama, comedy, spoken word and other performing arts, such as select titles in the Civic Nights, Club@The Civic, Jazz@The Civic and Millennial Theatre Project series; our annual All-City Musical; and all Family Series performances.

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH EVENTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR HUNTINGTON ACCESS FOR ALL?

Go to the website page of the event you're interested in and look for "Sponsored by Huntington Access for All." ***Please note that not all events are eligible for this program.***

IF I QUALIFY, HOW MANY TICKETS CAN I GET FOR AN EVENT?

During the Covid-19 pandemic, the Civic is operating with greatly reduced seating for events. Until the State of Ohio's Dept. of Public Health lifts its restrictions on attendance, we can only offer up to 4 tickets per household for qualifying events.

DO I QUALIFY FOR HUNTINGTON ACCESS FOR ALL TICKETS?

If you hold an Ohio EBT card, you can acquire tickets at the Akron Civic Theatre box office on the day of show by presenting your card.
